Join us this Thursday, March 23rd at 7pm in Perkins 217 for the next DCC Lecture Series event.

Guest speaker, Fr. Bill McConville will help us explore the ways in which Francis of Assisi, by opting for absolute poverty in imitation of Christ, chose to embrace a powerlessness which transformed the world in which we live.



MISERERE ET GUERRE

This Spring, Duke Chapel and the Nasher Museum of Art are hosting "*Miserere et Guerre*," a series of 58 intaglio prints by world-renowned French artist Georges Rouault (1871-1958).

The prints present an unapologetic religious devotion, persistent concern for the poor and marginalized, and searing criticism of the ruling class.

From March 5 through April 6, during Lent, Duke chapel will present images from the series that focus on Christ's redemptive sacrifice and the call for his disciples to journey with him to the cross. The Nasher Museum's tandem installation from March 18 to July 23, will highlight scenes that illustrate the plight of refugees and the devastations of war.
